Installation: The RSE is designed to be fully recessed into a ceiling or wall. Ideal for running remote loads and maintaining an architectural element.

Lamps: LR (PAR36), SR (PAR18) and BTMR (MR16) style heads are offered. Multiple lamp options are available. The LR and SR head types feature a unique twist locking collar that securely holds the lens and facilitates quick and easy re-lamping.



Torsion springs securely hold the RSE cover in place. This eliminates the need for screws and allows for quick and trouble free installation and general maintenance.

Housing: Durable 20G steel. White powder coat finish is standard, (other colors optional).

External test switch and monitor LED are standard.



internal

The **RSE** is configured with 120/277VAC input with solid state charging circuitry. Standard features include low voltage disconnect, AC lockout and brownout protection.

external

The **RSE** cabinet is constructed from durable 20 gauge steel. White powder coat finish is standard, (other colors optional). Emergency lighting heads are molded from high impact thermoplastic in a matching color. PAR36 (LR) style heads, PAR18 (SR) style heads and BTMR (MR16) style heads are offered. External test switch and monitor LED are standard.

Technical

emergency heads

The **RSE** is supplied with one, two or no heads. LR (PAR36), SR (PAR18) and BTMR (MR16) style heads are offered. BTMR heads are constructed of steel. The LR and SR thermoplastic heads feature a unique twist locking collar that securely holds the lens and facilitates quick and easy re-lamping.

electrical

BATTERY: The **RSE** is designed with a maintenance free, sealed valve regulated lead acid battery that provides a minimum emergency duration of 90 minutes. Optional nickel cadmium batteries are available. Recharge time of the battery is twenty-four [24] hours. The operating temperature is from 50°F up to 104°F (10°C up to 45° C).

CIRCUIT: The **RSE** utilizes a high-efficiency two stage charger providing precise float voltage control with low voltage disconnect protection. The charger also has brownout and short circuit protection. Charger status is easily determined via a dual diagnostic LED display which indicates AC/ON and High Charge. All components used in the circuitry are temperature compensated. An external push button test switch allows maintenance personnel to quickly determine the operational status of the unit and lamp load.

mechanical

Torsion springs firmly hold the **RSE** cover in place allowing for easy installation and maintenance. Remote lamp loads are connected to the emergency power supply with sturdy terminal connectors. These connectors allow for a large gauge of wire to be used, increasing the flexibility of installation.

autotest

The Beghelli Autotest system performs one 5 minute discharge test monthly. Every 6 months two 90 minute discharge tests are performed. This tests both full battery capacity and recharge capability, as required by the fire code. The information is communicated simply and intuitively to maintenance personnel via a single multi-color LED. When the LED is green the unit is functioning normally. If the LED is yellow there is a malfunction in the lamp circuit. A red LED indicates a battery or charger problem, including low battery capacity. The Beghelli Autotest system also includes 0, 5, 10 or 20 minute time Autotest delay function to allow HID lighting restrike.

- Red: Battery or Circuit Malfunction
- Yellow: Lamp Malfunctioning
- Green: Normal Operation
