

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

Read & Follow All Safety Instructions

When using electrical equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed including:

- Disconnect power before performing work on electrical equipment (using the light switch to turn off the power is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock)
- Do not mount near gas or electric heaters
- 2. 3. Do not install in unstable, loose or breakable surfaces and do not let objects impact or exert force on the surface of the fixture
- 4. Equipment should be mounted in locations and at heights where it will not be subjected to tampering by unauthorized personnel
- The use of accessory equipment not recommended by Beghelli Inc may cause an unsafe condition and will void the unit's warranty
- Do not use this equipment for other than its intended purpose
- Installation and servicing of this equipment should be performed by a qualified electrician familiar with the product and the hazards involved
- To prevent wiring damage or abrasion, do not expose wiring to edges of sheet metal or other sharp objects

- Verify correct supply voltage by comparing it with the luminaire label information
- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors
- Use minimum 90°C supply wires

- Avoid direct eye exposure to the light source while it is on
- Beware- small parts and packing material may be hazardous to children
- Risk of burn; Disconnect power and allow fixture to cool before handling 3.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

SURFACE MOUNT (Max. mounting height 25 ft)

- 1. Connect wire to 6-12VDC supply in accordance with local and national codes
- Secure fixture to junction box with hardware provided
